Following the application deadline, the Foundation will forward all completed applications and related documents to the selection committee. All applicants, whether they are awarded a scholarship or not, will be notified by May 31, 2024.

Application Process

Applicant **must** submit each of the following items considered:

1. Completed application form
2. EFC Score from your FAFSA (do not need the entire FAFSA, only the page with the EFC Score)
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation using the attached form. One letter should come from an academic reference (high school teachers, administrators, counselors, coaches) and one from a community reference. These must be current signed letters of recommendations.
4. An official and recent high school or college transcript with cumulative grade point average.
5. The ACT scorecard, the official SAT scorecard, or the WIN Career Readiness scorecard.

Check here if you are enrolled in a non-traditional curriculum or trade school.
If so, you only need to submit items 1 & 3 above.
